Björkliden is located in the Swedish Lapland, 250 kilometres north of the Arctic Circle, and is considered very snow-secure. The resort is situated 420 metres above sea level, and has a maximum vertical drop of 538 m. Björkliden has 5 ski lifts and 23 pistes, and easy access to good offpiste areas. The skiing season lasts from beginning of February until the beginning of May.

Riksgränsen is in the Northernmost part of Sweden, and is famous for its beautiful scenery, varied skiing and excellent snow conditions. The lifts go all the way up to an altitude of 909 m, and the base station is at 250 m. Riksgränsen is ideal for offpiste skiing, and heli-skiing is offered from April to the end of season. The ski resort opens in February and is open until the end May.

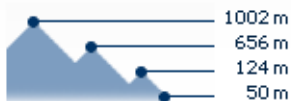

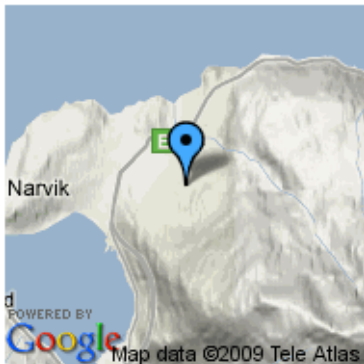

Narvik is located in Northern-Norway, the "land of the midnight sun", and is renowned for having the largest drop in Scandinavia, as well as the best offpiste conditions. The starting point for everyone who comes to Narvik to ski is Fagernesfjellet. The skiing area starts near the village at 200m, and the ski lifts take you up to 1000m in 10-15 minutes. The spectacular view from the top of the slopes is unique, since the runs go almost all the way down to the fjord. A gondola going parallel to the ski lifts takes you directly to the mountain restaurant at 600m. Due to the dark period in December and January, the period from march to June is considered high season in Narvik.

1. Touring on your own

The Glider

Our true classic for you who wants to easily experience the national park during winter! Take the chairlift up and follow the cross-marked trail southward. You will soon notice where the trail got its from. You can actually glide all the way down to the mountain station again!

To the Björkliden Ski Resort

From the mountain station at the top of chairlift, there is also a marked trail westward towards Björkliden. Follow it upwards to the pass between Nuolia and Slättatjåkka before you head down towards Björkliden's trail system. You might even have enough time for After-Ski before the train back to Abisko.

To the valley of Kårsavagge

Inside the high mountain valley of Kårsavagge is a very cosy hut. Walk under the railway and along the road up to the chairlift. On the other side of the bridge is the head of a marked trail. After following the Abiskojåkk stream, the trail leads up into the valley. A slightly longer tour that can be combined very well with a night in the hut.
